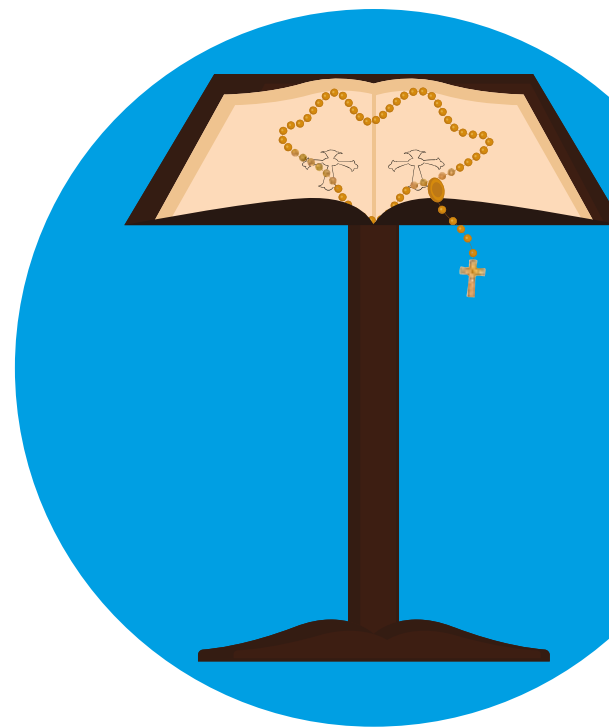


Gospel

Key Facts

1. The Sermon on the Mount is a collection of sayings and teachings by Jesus which emphasise his moral teachings.
2. The key themes of Jesus' teachings in the Sermon on the Mount were: foundations, peace, forgiveness, health and healing, prayer and generosity.
3. A gospel teaches us how we should live our lives through telling a story which has a meaning and context.
4. The meaning of a gospel can be different depending on the individual's interpretation.
5. The key themes from the Sermon on the Mount are still applicable today and are shown through Christian practice e.g. charity work.
